AERA-APA-NCME Committee on Guidelines and Standards or Educational Evaluation

This joint committee was established in 1975 to develop guidelines and standards for the conduct of educational evaluation. The group elected to expand the perspective of its deliberations and has invited single representatives from a number of practitioner organizations to join in the development of the guidelines. The organizations participating in the committee discussions include the American Association for School Administrators, the Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development, the American Federation of Teachers, the National Association of Elementary School Principals, the National Education Association and the National School Boards Association.

The Committee, estimating a four-year effort will be needed to develop guidelines, developed a proposal for funding. The Lilly Foundation has made the initial award to support the project for the first year, which was accepted by the Council in April (see *ER*, June, p. 16). Additional funds are being sought from other agencies.
